Global Volunteers is a non-profit corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota. In this Agreement, "Global Volunteers" means the corporation, its trustees, directors, officers, employees, team leaders, and agents. "You" and "your" refer to the minor signing this Agreement. "Guardian" refers to your parent or legal guardian signing this Agreement. "The Host" refers to the entity(ies) (e.g., school, clinic, hospital, organization, and/or government agency) which invited Global Volunteers and/or to which you are assigned to serve, and its employees, agents, officers, and directors. If anyone other than your Guardian will be accompanying you on a Global Volunteers Service Program, he/she will need to obtain an "authorization of temporary guardianship" form and have it signed by your Guardian. To obtain this form and/or receive additional information, please consult your state's attorney general's office or your legal advisor.

Global Volunteers will make all the necessary arrangements to provide you with the opportunity to work with and learn from local people with a team of volunteers in the community that you register for, subject to availability. You agree to volunteer your time and talents to the best of your ability following Global Volunteers guidelines and policies. For International Service Programs, you need a valid passport. **Do you have a valid passport?** Y N . **If not, have you applied or do you plan to apply for a passport?** Y N .

ADDITIONAL COSTS ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

The Service Program fee covers all meals, lodging, in-country ground transportation for international programs, administrative expenses, and project and program costs, except those expenses incurred during free time. You or your Guardian are responsible for any additional costs you may incur during free time and personal time, and for activities which are outside the Global Volunteers Service Program. Global Volunteers is not responsible for the acts or failures of anyone who provides services to you in connection with a Global Volunteers Service Program. For example, Global Volunteers is not responsible for any costs you may have because of delays or problems caused by any travel agent, airline, hotel, a foreign government, or the U.S. government.

TRAVEL DEVIATIONS

If you voluntarily deviate from Global Volunteers' scheduled itinerary, you may not be able to take the costs of the Service Program as a tax deduction. We recommend that you or your Guardian seek the advice of a tax advisor regarding this matter. (Please inform Global Volunteers of your travel plans so that we can coordinate your arrival and departure with the other members of the team.)

CANCELLATION AND REFUND

Global Volunteers may cancel any Service Program at any time. Global Volunteers may also reject an application anytime before departure. Global Volunteers will refund to TUA A the total amount paid to Global Volunteers on your behalf (1) if the Service Program is filled at the time you apply, (2) if Global Volunteers does not accept your application for any reason, or (3) if the Service Program is canceled for any reason other than a U.S. State Department travel warning that applies to the country to which you are traveling. **If you cancel your Service Program for any reason, you must notify Global Volunteers in writing.** Global Volunteers will not make refunds for unused portions of the Service Program or because of your inability to participate according to the

scheduled itinerary. If the Service Program is canceled because of a U.S. State Department travel warning that applies to the country to which you are traveling, you will receive a partial refund according to the standard refund schedule printed in Global Volunteers' Adventure in Service catalog and on the Website at www.globalvolunteers.org.

YOU PARTICIPATE AT YOUR OWN RISK

You and your Guardian acknowledge that there are dangers in traveling to and living and volunteering in the country you are applying for. You and your Guardian agree that you will travel and participate at your own risk. You and your Guardian agree to assume full responsibility for injury to you, including death and emotional trauma, and damage to or theft of your property.

YOU AGREE NOT TO SUE GLOBAL VOLUNTEERS

Neither you nor your Guardian will sue Global Volunteers, the Host, Trustees of Tufts University, or TUAA Travel-Learn Program if, in connection with this Service Program, you are injured or your property is damaged or stolen because of the negligence of Global Volunteers or the Host or because of the negligence or intentional acts of anyone else. If anyone, e.g., you, a family member, spouse, etc., sues Global Volunteers, the Host, Trustees of Tufts University or TUAA Travel-Learn Program because of injury to you or damage to your property because of the negligence of Global Volunteers or the Host, or because of the negligence or intentional acts of anyone else, you or your estate will reimburse Global Volunteers and the Trustees of Tufts University, or TUAA Travel-Learn Program for all judgments and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees. You may sue for intentional acts, gross misconduct or gross negligence caused by Global Volunteers.

As partial consideration for your being permitted to participate in the Global Volunteers program, your Guardian agrees to indemnify and hold Global Volunteers, Trustees of Tufts University, and TUAA Travel-Learn Program harmless from all claims, judgments, and costs, including attorney's fees, incurred in connection with any claims, demands, actions, or causes of actions brought by you or on your behalf other than intentional acts, gross misconduct or gross negligence.

YOU AGREE TO FOLLOW RULES AND LAWS

Global Volunteers requires that all volunteers arrive at the designated site by the scheduled service program arrival date. You will be the guest of the local people and Global Volunteers' host organization. You agree to follow all applicable rules, policies, and guidelines of Global Volunteers and the host, as well as the laws of the country and community. If you do not follow all rules, laws, policies, and guidelines, Global Volunteers' team leader has the authority to ask you to leave the community immediately. If you are asked to leave, you agree to leave the community immediately. Global Volunteers will transport you to the scheduled point of departure.

MINNESOTA LAW CONTROLS

You and your Guardian agree that this Service Program Application and Agreement is to be construed broadly under the laws of the State of Minnesota to provide a release, indemnification and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. In signing this Agreement, you and your Guardian acknowledge that (1) you have both read this entire document, (2) you both understand its terms, (3) your Guardian is at least eighteen (18) years of age, (4) by signing it both you and your Guardian are giving up substantial legal rights you might otherwise have, and (5) you have signed it knowingly and voluntarily. If any provision of this Agreement is unenforceable or too broad to be enforced to its full extent, then that provision and the remaining provisions will be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by law.
