

Travel to Wright Center 2008 Cryosphere workshop

After your application has been accepted-

You should contact Scott and let him know that you are about to make reservations for your travel. You are responsible for making and paying for your own reservations to and from The Glacier Institute in Glacier National Park including any layovers. We suggest a flight to Kalispell Montana and then a car rental to get into the park. After the workshop is filled we suggest that you contact other participants from the contact web page and share rides if possible.

To get to Glacier National Park

By Car

Visitors arriving by car will use U. S. Highway 2 to access the park from either the east or west. Visitors can also access the park from the north using Highways 89 or 17.

By Plane

Glacier Park International Airport in Kalispell, Montana is 25 miles west of park headquarters in West Glacier, Montana. There are also airports in Great Falls, Montana (200 miles east of West Glacier) and Missoula, Montana (156 miles south of West Glacier).

Car rentals are available at airports. Shuttles are available at the Kalispell airport.

By Train

Amtrak services both East Glacier and West Glacier. Glacier Park Inc., provides a shuttle service at these locations. Please call them at 406-892-2525 for more information.
