Our facility consists of over 40,000 square feet of hospital space, in which you have ready access to the region's most powerful [diagnostic imaging capabilities](#). We are proud to have the only high-strength MRI equipment for large animals in the region as well as X-ray, ultrasound and a state-of-the-art nuclear scintigraphy suite. As part of our efforts to continually upgrade our facilities, we have recently installed a 16-slice CT scanner. Our [clinical services](#)—including a modern surgical suites, intensive care unit, and sports medicine clinic—allow our clinical teams to diagnose and treat difficult and complex conditions in our clients' animals. Attached to the hospital is a modern pathology laboratory that provides diagnostic information daily for our patients. The Hospital for Large Animals also offers the only dedicated isolation facility in New England. This facility is separate from the main hospital and allows for isolation and treatment of animals with potentially infectious conditions.
